In the beginning, C.A.S.T. operated primarily in the summer, mounting musical productions out of Manchester High School's Bailey Auditorium.

However, since inception, C.A.S.T. has grown ten fold. C.A.S.T. now operates out of its own facility on Summit Street in Manchester, CT. C.A.S.T. has grown from a children's theatre group doing summer musicals to a full scale theatre group offering year-round productions, classes and workshops for children. There is also a splinter group known as C.A.S.T. players offering theatre productions for teens and adults. Each year we also produce an annual Parent & Alumni production.

The mission of C.A.S.T. is to enrich the lives of children through the magic of performing arts, thereby inspiring them to strive toward higher goals. We do this one line at a time, one show at a time, one child at a time.

We are a non-profit, community-based children's theatre dedicated to providing each and every child who comes to our door the opportunity to experience the joy of performing.
